ABOUT THE AWARDS

The Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST) is the Nation's highest honors for teachers of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM, including Computer Science).

Awardees receive:

- A certificate signed by the President of the U.S.
- A paid trip to D.C. for a series of recognition events and professional development opportunities.
- A \$10,000 award from NSF.
- An opportunity to build lasting partnerships with colleagues across the nations.

STATE/JURISDICTION COORDINATORS

Individuals are available in each state/jurisdiction to help you through the application process. They can connect you with a mentor, tell you if there are any local resources available to help you with the application, and they can share information about your state/jurisdiction-level recognition.

APPLICANT WEBINARS

Occur throughout the application cycle, including evenings and weekends, and can provide you with the chance to take an in-depth look at the application and ask any questions you may have. Many include a chance to speak to a past awardee. www.paemst.nsf.gov/webinar
